
EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MESSAGE

The Board of Directors is excited about the future and our potential to grow our impact and help more patients whose lives are being affected by breast cancer.




DISTRIBUTION OF GRANTS TO PATIENTS

Since 2001, The Hope Chest for Breast Cancer Foundation has distributed over \$2.9 million in financial assistance grants to over 6,000 Minnesota breast cancer patients and their families. In 2024, we provided 16.3% more non-medical grants over the previous year.

Each grant represents hope and relief, two elements that are crucial during the journey to recovery. It gives patients one less thing to worry about during their treatments.

Donations go directly to help patients that need immediate assistance, especially with a mortgage payment, providing grocery gift cards to help with their needs, paying for a vehicle repair so they can safely make their cancer treatment appointments, and in other cases paying for childcare so their children's care goes uninterrupted during a trying time.

U.S. Breast Cancer Stats

- Breast cancer is the most common cancer in American women, except for skin cancers.
- It is estimated that in 2024, approximately 30% of all new female cancer diagnoses will be breast cancer.
- Approximately 15% of women diagnosed have a family history of breast cancer. Those with a firstdegree relative (mother, sister, daughter) with breast cancer are nearly twice as likely to develop breast cancer themselves.
- The chance that a woman will die from breast cancer is 1 in 39, or about 2.5%.
- Women who receive regular screenings for beast cancer have a 26% lower breast cancer death rate than women who do not receive screenings.
- Approximately 13% of the female population in the U.S., will develop breast cancer in their lifetime.

- Breast cancer is the most common cancer in Minnesota women.
- In Minnesota there are about 4,800 new cases of breast cancer diagnosed in women each year.

WHO WE HELP

Our breast cancer patients range in age, demographic makeup, financial level, and location within Minnesota. The Foundation provides non-medical grants to all segments.

11% are on unpaid leave or unemployed, and are at risk of losing their insurance

1 in 5 lack reliable transportation to get to and from their appointments

51% of our patients have up to four dependents, these women are single mothers and caregivers

78% of our patients rely on a single income household

6% do not have stable housing

70% have household incomes of less than \$50,000

40% have household incomes less than \$25,000

54% of our patients are the primary income earner in the household

3% do not have health insurance






REVENUE SUMMARY

The Hope Chest for Breast Cancer Foundation receives revenue from three main categories including partner fundraising, private and business foundation grants, and Hope Chest events. Over the course of 2024 our revenues trended up over 2023, and we exceeded our budget goals. Revenue areas that significantly impacted the numbers were third-party fundraising partnerships, our two signature events, and sponsorships.

Community businesses and foundations champion nonprofit organizations by providing grants to support their mission, and the Hope Chest for Breast Cancer Foundation receives grants from the following:

Family Foundations – Private foundation whose funds are derived from members of a single family.

Public Foundations – Include a wide variety of charitable organizations, including hospitals, schools, churches, and organizations that make grants to others.

State Grant Process – Grant seekers can search for grant opportunities by state agency or by subject area.

The Hope Chest Foundation submitted grant requests related to community involvement, health and wellness, social involvement, etc. It was an extremely successful year with a 327% increase over 2023 from grant contributions.

Grants are a critical resource of vital funding. Therefore, the grant process is highly competitive. In 2024, telling our mission-driven story and providing current data in new, compelling ways has become increasingly important to judicious funders.

During 2024, requests incorporated the Hope Chest Expansion Plan into grant requests, seeking funds to support new patient cultivation and acquire new technology tools for the organization. Our mission is to deliver equal opportunity consideration to all breast cancer patients that seek a grant with our organization.

GRANTING HELP AND HOPE

"When I was diagnosed with breast cancer, I was so scared. I didn't know how our family would make it without my income. My husband and I have jobs that don't provide sick time or PTO. I also have a business as a photographer and had to close down due to treatment. I chose to go to Mayo clinic to participate in a trial drug for my kind of breast cancer. We are fortunate enough to only be two hours away from the clinic each way. The Hope Chest grant was detrimental in my care and fighting cancer and eventually, beating it. They provided me the financial assistance to pay for trips to and from appointments which were weekly, sometimes multiple times a week. They took away the burden of how we would manage our financial life with along with breast cancer. I am happy to say the trial worked and I do not have a cancer cell left. I am currently here receiving radiation treatments. Nobody tells you how difficult a breast cancer diagnosis is. There are so many things about it that drastically alter your way of life. It changes everything. The Hope Chest grant and their generosity changed our lives and allowed us to focus on getting me better. EXCEEDED OUR 2024 PLANS!

2024 in Review

We are proud to report the positive impact we accomplished throughout 2024. We concentrated our efforts on bringing more awareness of the foundation's grants, while providing more funding to our patients and their families throughout Minnesota, and the numbers say it all!

Exceeded patient grants 2024 over 2023 by 16.3%

Increased sponsorships 2024 over 2023 by 40%

Events revenue up in 2024 over 2023 by 15.2%

3rd party cause marketing/fundraising partner funds increased in 2024 over 2023 by **9.5**%

The following initiatives contributed to these positive increases.

- Grew our message with a new Hope Chest GO resource kit throughout greater Minnesota cities such as St. Cloud, Duluth, Rochester, Willmar, Bemidji, Grand Forks, Mankato, etc.
- Extended our community outreach to local civic organizations and rotary and veterans' clubs.
- Increased our presence in the private and public sectors, by approaching them with sponsorship and cause marketing opportunities.
- Tapped into more medical clinics and public health departments statewide as a two-fold approach of bringing awareness to the Hope Chest for Breast Cancer Foundation, while gaining attention for the Hope Chest GO grant program to help patients.
- Developed the Hope Ambassadors volunteer program where interested people helped at cause marketing events and Foundation events.
- Introduced a new event called the Pink Wave in conjunction with Back Channel Brewery that attracted a few hundred attendees and raised funds for the Foundation.
- Worked with TV partners creating more awareness and broader reach.

LOOKING AHEAD IN 2025

"Launching Us Forward"

The Hope Chest for Breast Cancer Foundation has exciting plans for 2025 by *Launching Us Forward* in the areas of communication, fundraising initiatives, community outreach, and strategic planning to enhance our combined efforts related to the foundation and the Hope Chest Resale Store. Our plans include:



Strategic Planning

- The Foundation will secure a professional consulting firm to facilitate a streamlined plan of
 action to ensure we are aligned and ready to move forward with a 3-year plan, helping us
 navigate transition and change, provide staff and Board of Directors with support, skills, and
 resources to proactively achieve our foundation's mission.
- The Foundation has secured funding from State, Local, and family foundations. There are **opportunities to obtain National Grants**, and we will be allocating additional efforts to apply for federal government grants available to nonprofits.

Communication

- New Website The website is the go-to location for information about the Hope Chest Foundation. We will implement a new Foundation website with the goal of an improved content management system, making it easier to add and update information, an expand online presence, including page navigation for guests, enhance the Resale Store section, add more Hope Chest GO patient information and language-translated materials, etc.
- Our continued goal will be to deliver our event and branding messages with media partners through mass email campaigns, digital marketing, publication ads, and TV appearances.
- The Foundation provides grants to breast cancer patients of all ages and ethnicities. We will
 help eliminate some communication barriers by producing an informational brochure that is
 posted as an online resource, translating brochures to Spanish, Hmong, and Somali.



Looking ahead in 2025 continued:

Fundraising Initiatives

- **Events** Our two signature events will continue, *Runway for Hope* and *Wine & Dine for Hope*. The event fundraising efforts include silent and live auctions, raffle, and Fundfor Hope efforts to raise funds for breast cancer patients.
- Fundraising Partners Businesses, organizations, and families dedicate time and
 energy to create fun and interactive ways to raise money for the Foundation, especially
 as it relates to October Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Donations increased for 2024
 by 9.5% over 2023, and our goal is to increase it by 10% in 2025. We will dedicate
 additional dollars through social media, dedicated eblasts, and Hubbard 2060 email
 campaigns to bring awareness and invite people to create and champion fundraising
 events.

Outreach Messaging

We made great strides with our outreach efforts in 2024, and our goal is to enhance our efforts in 2025.

- Expand our brand message throughout the 10-county metro area, plus expand our messaging to greater Minnesota with our Phase 2 campaign, bringing awareness of the Hope Chest Foundation and our Hope Chest Go program for patients.
- Continue to extend our community outreach to civic organizations.
- Continue to increase our presence in the private and public sectors.
- Develop more contacts and relationships with clinics and stakeholders specializing in oncology and the medical community.
- Bring awareness to the medical community and doctors of our programs and events to encourage participation by donating to the foundation and/or attending and supporting our events.
- Target oncologists and medical teams that focus in the sphere of breast cancer, as well as pharmaceutical, radiology, and mammalogy organizations to bring awareness of our brand and opportunities (sponsorship and event attendance) as it relates to Minnesota breast cancer patients.
- Plan to utilize our media partners' data and research tools to extend our reach through streaming, digital, and email platforms.
