Breast Cancer in Minnesota Women

How does Minnesota compare to our neighbors as it relates to breast cancer? Breast cancer incidence here is lower than lowa and Wisconsin, about the same as North Dakota, and slightly higher than South Dakota. Breast cancer accounts for over 30% of cancers diagnosed. The American Cancer Society estimates that there will be 5220 new cases in Minnesota this year. In general, the five-year survival rate for women with early-stage breast cancer in Minnesota is about 99%.
