Breast Cancer Incidences Still Rise

A 2024-2025 American Cancer Society (ACS) report finds that the incidence of breast cancer in women has continued to increase, rising by 1% a year during 2012 to 2021, for all women combined. Typically, the disease occurs in women older than age 50, so it's concerning that women younger than age 50 saw a steeper increase in breast cancer (increasing 1.4% a year) than women older than 50 (0.7% a year). *Source: American Cancer Society*

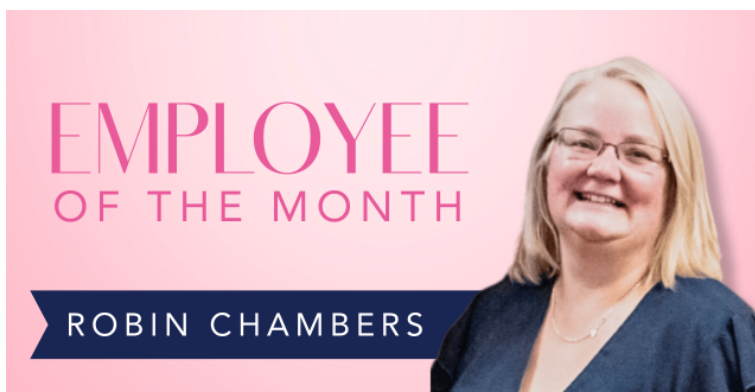
Wine & Dine for Hope is Moving to the Four Seasons!
